TRANSFORMING TESTS

'Death by M/C Qs' seems to be the punishment God gave teachers in the wake of Adam and Eve's transgression. Yet it does not have to be like that. Although most of us have to use exam materials in class for reasons of face validity, we can in fact 'tweak' them so that students actually find them interesting. The aim of this workshop is to demonstrate four easy-to-use techniques, which can both motivate learners and help them do better in exams.
